



EMS Careers Scholarship Application

Mobile Medical Response, Michigan's largest geographical provider of Emergency Medical Services has established a scholarship program for those seeking long term careers within the EMS industry. The program is designed to provide funding for MMR's Saginaw or Mt. Pleasant based EMT-Basic courses. Students have the option of applying for an evening program that begins in January, or our traditional program that would begin in late August. The scholarship covers the cost of tuition for the program. Students are responsible for books and technology fees.

A shortage of qualified personnel in Michigan, and across the United States, has created staffing challenges for many EMS organizations. MMR is seeking energetic and compassionate individuals with the desire to help others and serve their community. Students who train through our Education Department are fully prepared to challenge the EMT National Registry exam and obtain their EMT license. Successful candidates are eligible to apply for employment with MMR and become part of a team that provides high quality pre-hospital care and medical transportation to the communities we serve. EMT's working for MMR are eligible for an additional scholarship for MMR's Paramedic course. EMT-Basic is the first step, pre-requisite for Paramedic training.

Eligibility and academic requirements, the application process and personal information to be included are contained on the following pages. Candidates must submit an essay and participate in an interview with the selection committee.

Scholarship Eligibility:

Applicants must be:

- At least 18 years of age by May 31st or December 31st for (Traditional Program)
- Participate in interview process with selection committee

Program Eligibility:

- No felony arrests or convictions
- Negative drug screen
- Valid Michigan Driver's License
- Acceptable driving record, in accordance with MMR's auto insurance carrier

Additional Documentation:

- Essay describing career goals
- Letter of recommendation

Tuition Awards

- EMT tuition scholarship award valued at \$1,000
- Student responsible for books and technology fees

Selection Committee

- Recipients will be chosen by a selection committee from Mobile Medical Response which includes a representative from a local ISD Career Training Center.

Selection of Recipients

- Scholarship recipients will be selected based on their academic record, behavior in school and community, essay and interview.

Timelines for Scholarship

- Applications due to MMR, along with all supporting documents by October 15th of for January start program; by April 30th for August start program.
- Interviews will occur during the months of November and May.
- Scholarship winners will be announced in early December and early June.
